Bruce has guest starred on numerous shows: Space Force, NCIS LA, Hawaii Five-O, Psych, Cold Case, Huff, NYPD Blue, The Agency, Walker Texas Ranger, VIP, Arli\$\$, Murder She Wrote, and more.

Bruce Locke can be seen on Season 4 of Amazon Prime's The Man in the High Castle as General Yamori, the Commander of the American states occupation. He also is recurring as a Guest Star on Doug Liman's Impulse on Season 2 and NCIS on season 14. Bruce was asked to return for the Series Finale of NYPD Blue to portray a different character in an unusual move of never using the same actor for different roles. HARUKI MURAKAMI was born in Kyoto in 1949 and now lives near Tokyo. His work has been translated into more than fifty languages. The most recent of his many international honors is the Jerusalem Prize, whose previous recipients include J. M. Coetzee, Milan Kundera, and V. S. Naipaul.

Bruce starred as Kabuo Miyamoto on stage in *Snow Falling on Cedars* at the Portland Center Stage. In New York, he acted in *Widescreen Version of the World* at the Circle Rep Theater, In L.A. in numerous productions including *The Male Box*, *Year of the Dragon*, *Mortal Kombat Live*.

Bruce's voice work spans the spectrum from animation, video games, film, and documentary narration, commercials, dubbing to English, Complete Voice replacement to elevate another actor's performance, to Audio Books.

Bruce narrated Haruki Murakami's novel, *Colorless Tsukuru Tazaki*, which was #1 on the New York Times best seller list. His narration of the Documentary *Massacre at Hell's Canyon* about the murder of 34 Chinese miners won an Emmy. Extensive voice work in video games and animation, Bruce is a recurring character on Nickelodeon's *The Loud House*, and *The Casagrandes*.

Bruce Locke is 6'2" and played professional tennis. He a leading man who modeled in America, Europe, and Asia, but has the acting career of a character actor...from period to contemporary, from urban to rural. Bruce has played military generals from the middle ages of Asia, to the 1960 Japanese governor general in charge of the occupation of America in the Man in the High Castle, to a 2020 three star Chinese general in Netflix's Space Force. Bruce has played warriors, corperate leaders, detectives, and ancient elders from 80 (on Impulse) to 500 years old (Mortal Kombat Conquest). He specializes in the Asian mafia leader, the bad man. Not a martial artist, Bruce made a name in the action genre, and many enthusiasts know him from portraying the cybor ninja, Otomo, in Robocop 3 as well as the sorcerer Shang Tsung, in the Mortal Kombat television series.

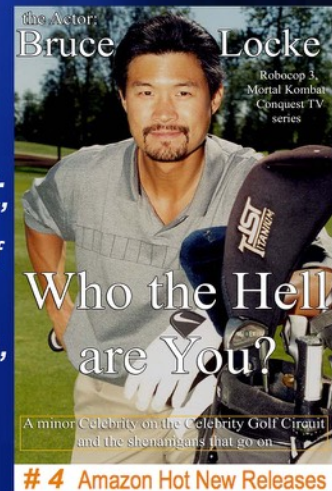

Biography

Raised in Portland, Oregon, Bruce attended the United States Naval Academy Program and graduated from Pitzer College with degrees in Mathematics and Economics. He turned to professional tennis after being nationally ranked in college, but fell into acting and retired.

Bruce was Robocop's nemesis, Otomo, in the film Robocop 3. He has been cast as a series regular for CBS, FOX, WB, and Nickelodeon shows.

As a writer, Bruce has placed or won in both feature and TV screenwriting competitions: Nicholl Fellowship (AMPAS), CAPE (Finalist in the TV category -Coalition of Asian Pacific Artists), PGA Pitch program (Producers Guild of America), and the Final Draft Big Break TV competition.

From Bruce's love of golf, he became a scratch golfer and nearly qualified for the TV final round of the U.S. Senior Open Golf championship. Helping to raise millions of dollars, Bruce has participated in Celebrity golf fundraisers for over 20 years, sometimes hosting the event galas. His humorous book of his time spent with famous entertainers and athletes, *Who the Hell Are You?*, reached #4 on Amazon's best seller list.

Working in Film, TV, Theater, and Voice, Bruce has also filmed almost 100 commercials.
